

Grade 6 – Immunization Clinic

Public Health Nurses will be at the *North Saanich Middle School* to complete immunizations for Grade 6 students who would normally have completed their immunizations at school in the Spring:

Monday, June 15, 2020 from 9:15am to 12:00 noon, in the *Gym*. Parents can park in the church parking lot. The entrance to the clinic will be through the gym doors in front of the under covered area. The exit will be through the other gym doors by the side of the field.

Only students with a signed permission/consent form on file (done last fall) will be immunized.

We recognize not all Grade 6 students will be attending school, or they will have limited days or hours in June. This school-based clinic is an opportunity to bring your child in to ensure their immunizations are on time and up-to-date regardless of whether or not they are registered at the school for the month of June. As Public Health Nurses we will have strict guidelines to ensure adequate physical spacing, cleanliness, etc.

Prior to attending this school-based clinic, please note your child cannot attend this clinic if you answer 'Yes' to any of the following questions-

- Does your child or anyone in your home have a runny nose, sore throat, fever, cough, shortness of breath or trouble breathing, diarrhea or vomiting?
- Has your child or anyone in your household travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days?
- Has your child or anyone in your household been in contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19?

If any of these symptoms or exposures arise, we ask that you contact the health unit to make alternate arrangements for your child's immunizations.

Please ask your child to wear a short-sleeved shirt and to bring a snack for before and/or after their immunizations. They will be waiting for 15-minutes under adult supervision as this is recommended following any immunizations.

If parents accompany their child, we ask that you wait outside the school as we need to ensure the safety of all the students and nurses.
