Please also see the attached Daily Health Screening Check. We ask you to ensure this is completed before your child attends school on Thursday or Friday of this week. No need to print it off - just be sure to go through it with your child. Each student will receive two paper copies of this health check on Thursday or Friday. One of the copies has a place to write your child's name and division number on it and this one is to be completed and submitted to the homeroom teacher during the first full week of school, preferably for Monday, September 14, 2020. The other copy is meant to go on the fridge or another location that will remind you to ensure the screening has been completed for your child each day.

Things may have to be changed periodically through the year, but we will do our best to keep you informed. School information can be accessed in several ways. Important and timely

information will be emailed home and updated on our website. Our school website at [www.northsaanich.sd63.bc.ca](http://www.northsaanich.sd63.bc.ca) is regularly updated and contains information on upcoming school activities. Many of our teachers have homework pages that include school and classroom information, we have a NSMS twitter account at @SD63NSaanich and our school sign is updated with current information and events. Additionally, you can sign up on our webpage and have all school updates sent to your email and phone.

Your children will meet their teachers and classmates this week. The staff has spent many hours working with our feeder schools to place our students so that each student will be placed in a class that gives them the best opportunity for academic and social success. We do not have the ability to make class placement changes after students have started class on Thursday, September 10, 2020. We will, however, help every child feel welcome and accepted in their classroom.

This year, teachers will be reaching out to you by email, phone, or MS TEAMS, rather than having you come into the school. Our goal is to connect with parents to learn about your child and open the lines of communication between home and school. We believe that understanding your child and developing positive relationships is the key to a successful school year.

- We will meet students near and around the Hawk's Nest (play structure) in front of the school, and we will have staff there to greet you and direct you to our class lists and student gathering zone on the field. For health and safety reasons, the gathering area on the field will be restricted to students and staff.
- First day of full classes is **Monday, September 14, 2020**.
