StoryWalk® with the Horses: August 26th

Follow the trail at Centennial Park in Central Saanich and read along with each page of the Story *If I Had a Horse* by Gianna Marino. When you get to the end of the Story, Cisco and Bangsi, two local horses from the Victoria Therapeutic Riding Association will be waiting to meet you.
